

Town of Union
Board Meeting Minutes
January 18, 2017

Chairman Marv Merle called the January 18, 2017 Town of Union Board Meeting to order at 5:18 p.m. at the Webster Fire Hall, Webster WI.

Members present: Marv Merle, Wayne Burmeister, Kathy Krinkie, Gene Ackland, and Kim Johnson

Others present: Glen Krinkie, Al Steiner

Motion by Marv Merle, seconded by Gene Ackland to approve the minutes of the December 16, 2016 meeting, the December 2016 Treasurer's report and pay the January 2017 bills. Motion carried. 3-0

Al Steiner was present to be sworn in as the official Fire Chief for the Town of Union. Motion by Gene Ackland, seconded Wayne Burmeister to accept Al Steiner as Fire Chief. Motion carried. 3-0

Old Business:

A brief discussion was held regarding Willow Park. Marv presented the board with a letter he had received regarding this property from the DNR. Motion by Marv Merle, seconded by Gene Ackland to continue the pursuit to sell the Willow Park property. Motion carried. 3-0

New Business:

Marv Merle explained that Brittany Fry, Public Health Specialist, Burnett County, had requested to be added to the agenda to explain a grant that had been received to provide education on well water testing and arsenic. Approximately 5 test kits per township will be presented to each township for volunteers to test their wells. Brittany was unable to attend the meeting.

Dave Grindell had also requested to be on the agenda but was not able to make it.

The 2017 Transportation Aids have been awarded. Union Township will be receiving \$82,376.82.

Motion by Gene Ackland, seconded by Wayne Burmeister to apply for the Road Grant by the Burnett County Forest & Parks if time permits to gather the necessary information. Motion carried. 3-0

Motion by Marv Merle, seconded Gene Ackland to move the polling location for the Town of Union to Forts Folle Avoine for the February 21, 2017 Spring Primary if it is still acceptable to the Forts to use their facility. Motion carried. 3-0

Motion by Marv Merle, seconded by Wayne Burmeister to remove David Olson from the accounts at Community Bank and add Kim Johnson, the new clerk. Also, request that the township be set up with on-line banking. Motion carried. 3-0

Motion by Gene Ackland, seconded by Wayne Burmeister to adjourn at 6:10 p.m. Motion carried. 3-0
